Seminar Space

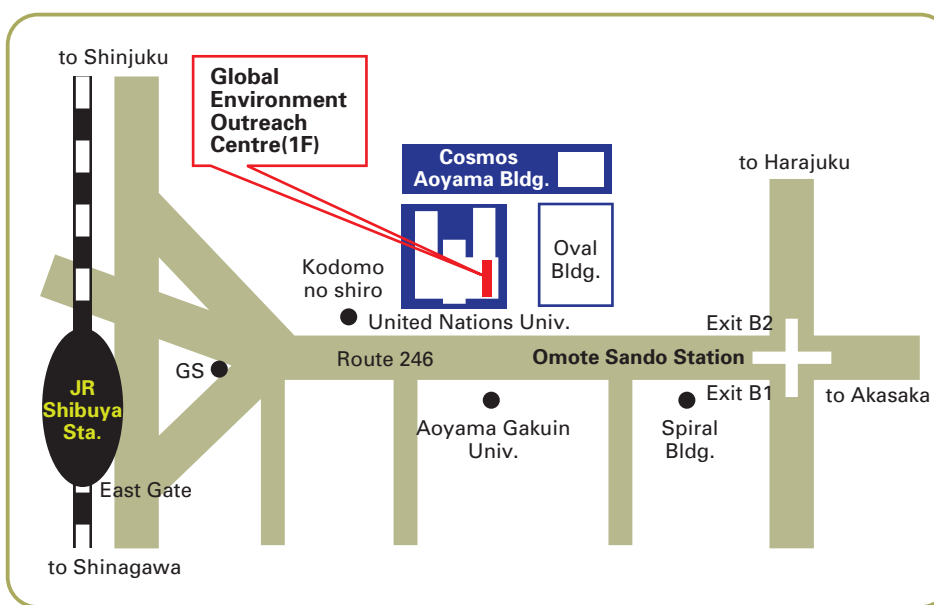
This is a space used for holding seminars and workshops to encourage environmental protection and sustainable development.
