Temporary Closure of the Facilities of the Global Environment Outreach Centre (GEOC)

Japan

To support measures to limit the spread of COVID-19, the United Nations University (UNU) head-quarters building in Shibuya, Tokyo, is closed for the period 9 April 2020 – 6 May 2020. During this period access to the building is limited to critical staff only, and no visitors will be permitted to enter any facilities in the building. This arrangement may be extended further.

Ensuring the safety of visitors to GEOC is our highest priority, and considering the measures implemented by UNU, *all GEOC facilities located in the UNU headquarters building will remain closed until* **30 June 2020**. This decision has been taken after careful assessment of the situation by the Environmental Partnership Office, Ministry of the Environment Japan and the GEOC project team, UNU Institute for the Advanced Study of Sustainability (UNU-IAS).

We sincerely apologise for any inconvenience caused by the closure of GEOC facilities, especially to those who were planning to use them during the period.
